Day one

Arrival to Moscow

Moscow is one of the ten largest megacities in the world and the largest city in Europe and Russia. More than 12 million people live here. The city is named after the eponymous river flowing through it.



Day two

Moscow City tour and the Tretyakov Gallery

The 2nd day of the tour is dedicated to visiting Red Square, St. Basil's Cathedral, GUM. A pleasant end of the day and its highlight will be a visit to the Tretyakov Gallery, where you should definitely see the

most famous works of the Russian painting - Malevich's Black Square, Shishkin's Morning in a Pine Forest, Vasnetsov's Heroes, Ivan the Terrible and his Son Ivan 16 November 1581 by Repin and many others.



Day three

Tour to the Kremlin and the Armoury Chamber

Today you will visit the unique tourist, spiritual and political place in modern Moscow - the Moscow Kremlin, which is the largest medieval fortress in the world and the oldest building in Moscow.



Day four

Kazan City Tour, The Kremlin of Kazan and a cooking class

This day is dedicated to visiting Russia's third capital – the city of Kazan.

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Day five

The Sviyazhsky Monastery and the Chuck-Chuck Museum

Today you will visit the Sviyazhsky Monastery - one of the most popular tourist sites in Tatarstan. Sviyazhsk was founded by decision of Ivan the Terrible as a fortress in 1551. The city became the first Orthodox city in the Middle Volga region, Christianization of people of the Volga region came from here.

City tour in Yekaterinburg and visit to the “Ganina Yama”

Day seven
On Board the train

This day, you will travel a distance about 1600 kilometers from Yekaterinburg to Novosibirsk with the main stops at the train stations of Tyumen and Omsk.

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Day eight
On Board the train

This day you will travel a distance about 1300 kilometers from Novosibirsk to Nizhneudinsk with a long stop at the Krasnoyarsk train station.

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Day nine
On Board the train. Arrival to Irkutsk

This day, you will travel 500 kilometers and arrive in Irkutsk in the evening.

Listvyanka Village Tour, Baikal Museum and “Taltsy” Museum

Listvyanka is a village located at the source of the Angara River, the only river flowing from Lake Baikal. “Taltsy” Museum - an open-air museum of wooden architecture located in Taltsy Village.
